

Miss Tennessee TriStars

The official Tennessee chapter of the Miss America Little Sisters program TriStars are an official part of the **Miss Tennessee Scholarship Competition**, the only competition in the state of Tennessee officially licensed by the **Miss America Organization**.

Role models are important. Miss Tennessee is one of the best.

Each year, an extraordinary group of intelligent, talented women compete for the title, with one representative moving on to the Miss America stage. We invite **young girls (ages 5–12)** to join us for a fun-filled week at the **Fisher Center for the Performing Arts** in Nashville from **Wednesday, June 17, through Saturday, June 20, 2026**.

As a TriStar, your child will be mentored by a Miss Tennessee candidate, accompany her onstage, and perform an energetic dance routine during the competition. This program is a wonderful opportunity to build poise, grace, and confidence while creating lifelong friendships and unforgettable memories.

The one-time **\$500 Registration Fee** provides your TriStar with the following:

- Participation in an on-stage choreographed dance number during prelim nights of the 2026 Miss Tennessee Scholarship Competition
- Introduction on stage during one night of the Miss Tennessee competition with her candidate
- Introduction at the TriStar Program crowning event during competition week
- Two upper-level tickets to all nights of the Miss Tennessee Scholarship Competition (One ticket is for the TriStar; the other ticket is for a parent or guardian.)
- Official TriStar Crown and Sash
- Official TriStar T-Shirt and Bag
- Photo and Name in the Miss Tennessee Scholarship Competition Program Book
- Participation in fun events throughout competition week (see **tentative** schedule)

PHOTO REQUIREMENTS: You should email the following to **briannabroadly714@gmail.com** using your TriStar's name in the subject line: • A current 5 x 7 color headshot for the Official State Program Book. This photo should be high resolution (1 MB or larger) and should be head and shoulders only. No crowns or hats in the picture. Please note that your photo must be submitted by the paperwork deadline of May 1st, 2026 or your TriStar will not be featured in the program book. Make arrangements to have this photo taken well before the deadline.*

Requirements for participation:

- **Age Requirement:** Applicants must be between the ages of 5 and 12 years old as of June 1, 2026.
- **Participation Fee:** A one-time \$500 Registration Fee is required to participate. \$25 deposit is able to be paid to secure your spot. Please pay your remaining fee using this [link](#) : by **May 1st, 2026**.
 - a. **New sibling discount for 2026-** \$500 for the first registrant, \$400 for each subsequent registrant

- **Wardrobe requirements:**

- a. **White party/pageant/formal floor-length dress** with age-appropriate white, nude, or clear shoes. For safety concerns, the shoes should be secure when dancing, climbing stairs, etc. (no slides/slip-ons or high heels). **See last pages of this document for example gowns.**

- b. **Production number attire:**

THEME: "TENNESSEE TRISTARS: WILD AT HEART", inspired by Zootopia 2

COLOR SCHEME: animal print, black, and hot pink.

OUTFIT: Option 1- animal print outfit (cheetah, leopard, zebra, tiger, giraffe) can be a dress or skirt with shorts underneath, romper, two piece outfit, jumpsuit, appropriate for dancing. Option 2- animal print top (cheetah, leopard, zebra, tiger, giraffe) with black bottom, or black top with animal print bottom (cheetah, leopard, zebra, tiger, giraffe). *If the bottom is a skirt, must wear shorts underneath. Bottoms must be appropriate length.

SHOES: black tennis shoes or boots that are appropriate to dance in

ACCESSORIES: hot pink jewelry, jacket, vest, hair bows, socks, accessories. May add rhinestones, sequins, ect.

REQUIREMENTS: must be age appropriate length, neckline, and style. NO strapless, cutouts, low cut necklines.

- c. **Three to four age appropriate short fancy party** dresses/outfits (at or slightly above the knee; color and style of your choice) to wear for TriStar Crowning Ceremony and special events throughout the week. **See last pages of this document for examples.**
 - d. **Red short cocktail/Sunday dress-** for Red Gala *ticketed event, attendance not required
 - e. **Tea Party attire-** Miss Tennessee Tea Party *ticketed event
 - f. T-shirts, shorts/capris/pants, jacket/sweater, and tennis shoes for practices and activities.

Ad Requirements

You will create the ad page as you would like it to be printed and submit as a **high-resolution pdf or image**. We will publish whatever you submit. All electronic files must meet the technical requirements shown below. As you begin designing your ads, go ahead and create full pages of ads. For instance, if you sell two half page ads, go ahead and design them on a full page. If you sell a half page ad and a fourth page ad, go ahead and place the fourth of a page ad on the same page as the half page ad. This will help to speed our production process.

All submitted electronic files need to meet the following technical requirements:

Final page size: 8 1/2" X 11"; 1/8" bleed (any artwork that goes to the edge of the page must continue at least 1/8" past the edge of the page), B/W ads should be in grayscale, 300 dpi; Color ads should be in CMYK, 300 dpi Acceptable file formats:

- PDF or EPS – save as high resolution and press-ready. Photos and graphics must be at least 300 dpi and all fonts must be embedded.
- JPEG or TIFF – Must be actual size and at least 300 dpi in grayscale or CMYK mode. We recommend saving JPEGs as high quality.

Ad Submissions

You will submit your ads and a form listing EVERY ad you've sold in May. A link to these instructions will be provided. You should submit payment for ads as you sell and receive the payment.

Rebates and Incentives: Fund Your Experience!

\$500 color full-page ad: \$100 rebate

\$300 black and white full-page ad: \$60 rebate

\$150 black and white half-page ad: \$30 rebate

Other Sponsorship Packages and Incentives:

TriStars have the opportunity to sell other sponsorship opportunities in order to receive great prizes and rebates.

\$750 T-Shirt Sponsorship: Businesses can have their information displayed on the back of the t-shirts worn by contestants, TriStars, and volunteers during competition week for increased visibility. Sponsorship includes a 1/5 page color logo and thank you in the program book. (First five applicants receive the sponsorship opportunity, THESE ARE ALREADY TAKEN!) Contestants selling one of these sponsorships get \$750 credit towards sponsorship sales totals and will serve as the social media cover model for the t-shirt during competition week.

\$1200 Meal Sponsorship: Businesses can sponsor a meal for Miss Tennessee and Miss Tennessee's Teen contestants and volunteers during the week. Sponsorship includes signage at the meal, social media post, ability for a representative(s) from the business to dine with Miss Tennessee contestants, a half-page black and white ad in the program book, and one copy of the program book. Contestants selling one of these sponsorships get \$1200 credit towards sponsorship sales totals OR the value of the meal donated should they acquire an in-kind sponsor restaurant willing to donate the meal (meal for 60). Meal must be pre-approved from the Miss and Teen Director to avoid duplication.

Sponsorship Levels: Businesses and individuals have the opportunity to sponsor our program through the following named sponsorship levels. These must be **MONETARY** sponsors. The information below details first what the **BUSINESS OR SPONSOR** receives and then details the reward provided to contestants who sell these packages.

\$1000: Business/Sponsor receives half-page black and white program book ad, 2 social media posts, one season ticket, and one copy of the program book; Contestants selling this sponsorship get \$1000 credit toward sponsorship sales totals and a \$100 rebate

\$2,500: Business/Sponsor receives half-page color program book ad, 4 social media posts and 1 short-form video, two season tickets, and two copies of the program book; Contestants selling this sponsorship get \$2500 credit toward sponsorship sales totals and a \$200 rebate.

\$5,000: Business/Sponsor receives a full-page color program book ad, 6 social media posts and 2 short-form videos, two season tickets in the VIP section, two copies of the program book, one appearance by Miss Tennessee, and recognition from stage during each preliminary and finals night, with event title sponsorship available; Contestants selling this sponsorship get \$5000 credit toward sponsorship sales totals and a \$300 rebate.

\$7,500: Business/Sponsor receives a full-page color program book ad, 8 social media posts and 3 short-form videos, two season tickets in the VIP section, three copies of the program book, two appearances by Miss Tennessee, recognition from stage during each preliminary and finals night, a scholarship named in their honor, with event title sponsorship available; Contestants selling this sponsorship get \$7500 credit toward sponsorship sales totals and a \$400 rebate.

\$10,000: Business/Sponsor receives a full-page color program book ad near the front of program book, 10 social media posts and 5 short-form videos, 4 season tickets in the VIP section, four copies of the program book, recognition from stage during each preliminary and finals night, three appearances by Miss Tennessee, a scholarship named in their honor, and presenting sponsorship status; Contestants selling this sponsorship get \$10,000 credit toward sponsorship sales totals and a \$500 rebate.

Awards:

Top Ad Sales TriStar Winner - TriStar with the highest combined ad sales and sponsorship packages will be recognized onstage at the Miss Tennessee Contestant Welcome Ceremony (must sell at least \$1500 in combined ad sales and sponsorship packages). She will receive a photoshoot with Miss Tennessee during Miss Tennessee week at the Fisher Center. She will also be invited to appear onstage and walk in the Miss Tennessee Sendoff Fashion Show and receive a free ticket for herself and a parent to attend the event (held in August). She will have her picture featured on the TriStar Page of the Miss Tennessee website and on the TriStar & Miss Tennessee social media pages.

Stars for Scholars Club – TriStars with a minimum of 4 ad pages (must fill 4 full pages, \$1200 in ads OR has at least \$1200 in combined ad sales and sponsorship packages) will receive a trophy/plaque and recognition at the Miss Tennessee Contestant Welcome Ceremony and have her picture featured on the TriStar Page of the Miss Tennessee website and on the TriStar & Miss Tennessee social media pages.

Photogenic Winner - A panel of judges will select a Photogenic Winner from the photos submitted for ads (minimum 1 full page to qualify). The Photogenic winner will receive a plaque and recognition at the Miss Tennessee Contestant Welcome Ceremony and have her picture featured on the TriStar Page of the Miss Tennessee website and on the TriStar & Miss Tennessee Facebook pages.

Ad Page Idea ideas:

1. Business or marketing page - help market a business by promoting them in your social media (exposure is what they want),
2. Hometown page - Have a page about your Hometown; feature its city leadership, businesses, clubs, groups, high school/college, etc. Make sure you are in the photo(s). Ask your local chamber of commerce for support.

4. Community Service Initiative page – showcase your involvement with your platform
5. Support page – these are from family and friends wishing you good luck and wanting to support you; make sure YOU are in the picture and list the name of those who chip in.

All images or colour that print to the edge of your document should be extended into this area to avoid the chance of any white lines appearing. Do not place any content that you wish to appear in your document in this area as it will be trimmed off.



Non Text Area: Avoid putting any text .125 inches from the edge of the document. Text placed in this area will run very close to the edge of the document and could possibly get trimmed off. If possible also avoid using any thin borders in this area as you may get inconsistent thickness.



Trim Area: This is the finished size of your document. Anything placed outside of this area will be trimmed off.

Select "trim marks"

Set all "Bleeds" to .125 inches
